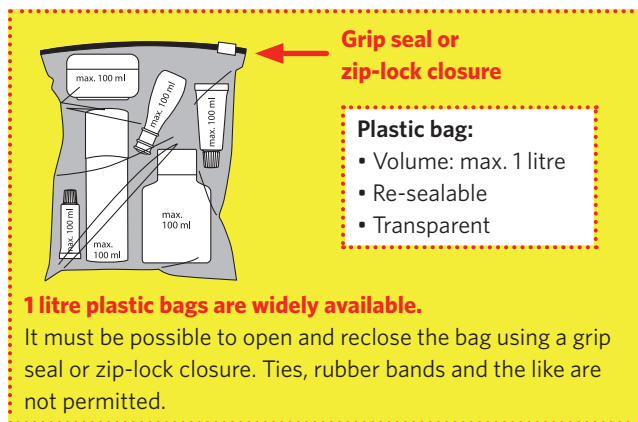


Liquids in hand luggage

European Union (EU) regulations governing the transport of liquids in hand luggage apply equally in Switzerland. This includes passengers who depart from Switzerland and those who transfer in Switzerland.

Liquids, gels, creams etc. are only permitted in hand luggage in containers with a maximum size of 100 ml (1 dl)

- All containers (tubes, jars, bottles) must be able to fit easily in a transparent, re-sealable plastic bag (such as a freezer bag) with a maximum size of one litre.
- This plastic bag must be presented for inspection at the airport security check.
- Only one plastic bag per person is allowed. This limit also applies to children and babies.



Exceptions:

- Liquid prescription medications which are required throughout the entire journey. Please have a medical certificate available for these items.
- Non-prescription medications (nose sprays, contact lens cleaners etc.) in travel-sized amounts.
- Baby food in amounts required for the journey.

You may continue to purchase duty-free articles in amounts exceeding 100 ml. The shop where they are purchased will seal them in a plastic bag which may be opened only after your flight.

Moving quickly through security checks

Put everything in your handbag or jacket

Put small electronic items, metal objects, keys, wallets and mobile telephones in your jacket or handbag and place the jacket or handbag in a container at the security checkpoint.

Keep plastic bag with liquids separate

Place this bag in the container separately from other items.

Unpack laptops

Take your laptop computer out of its case or sleeve and place it in a separate container.

Repacking zone

At the end of the security checkpoint you will find a repacking zone where you can pack your belongings again and return any security check containers.

Non-compliant containers

Containers of liquids, gels or similar substances which hold more than 100 ml or do not comply with security regulations will be confiscated at the security checkpoint and disposed of. Please dispose of any beverage containers before you go through the security check.
