**BENGALURU INT. AIRPORT,
BANGALORE INDIA**

Project Summary

Bengaluru International Airport was developed as a Greenfield airport and went operational on May 24, 2008 after a construction time of 35 months. At the same time the existing HAL airport closed for commercial traffic. Bangalore International Airport Ltd. (BIAL) is set up as a public private partnership between the following partners:

- Siemens (40%)
- GVK (29%)
- Flughafen Zürich AG (FZAG) (5%)
- Airport Authorities of India (13%)
- Government of Karnataka (13%)

BIAL's concession to operate the airport is granted for 30 years, with a renewal option for another 30 years. The expansion of T1 for a total capacity of 17 million passengers is currently ongoing and will be operational in 2012.

Involvement of Zurich Airport

FZAG holds 5% in BIAL, the owner and operator of the airport. In December 2009 FZAG successfully divested 12% of its total shareholding of 17% to GVK. Additionally, FZAG has entered into an Operation and Management Services Agreement (OMSA) with BIAL. Under the OMSA, FZAG rendered services in the fields of staffing, construction management, start-up preparation, operational, commercial and financial management.

More than 100 experts of FZAG spent over 1,200 man-days for consulting in the different fields of expertise during the construction phase. Further services will be rendered for at least the first seven years of airport operation.
